1. Where can I read information about operating the VPG-2100?

2. What will happen if my display does not have an EDID?

The VPG-2100 does not support video sinks that do not have a valid EDID.

3. What is the function of the additional ports on the back of the VPG-2100?

These ports are not used. Do not attach anything to these ports. Only use the power adapter and two upper video outputs.

4. What is the function of the USB ports?

The USB ports on the front of the device are used for system updates and library imports. More information regarding their function is detailed in the VPG-2100 Quickstart Guide.

5. How many displays can the VPG-2100 drive at once?

The VPG-2100 can drive up to two displays simultaneously. These can be in any combination (DP and HDMI, DP Multistream, DP and DVI, etc.).

6. Why did the VPG not properly display a timing in my device's EDID?

Not all timings are supported by the VPG-2100. For instance, the minimum resolution for HDMI is 720p and for DisplayPort it is 300x200. For a full list of limitations, please read the VPG-2100 ReadMe. Visit http://downloads.vprime.com/ to download the document.
